



Emergency medical technicians, or EMTs, work in an ambulance and respond to emergency situations. An EMT – Paramedic is also called an EMT-P, which means emergency medical technician-Paramedic. The EMT-P will provide emergency medical care, medications and intravenous fluids. EMT-P’s work with emergency medical technician (advanced/intermediate or basic) in an ambulance and with anyone they are assisting.

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) - Tasks

- Administer basic first-aid treatment and advanced life-support care to sick or injured persons in prehospital setting.
- Perform emergency diagnostic and treatment procedures within the Georgia Paramedic scope of practice.
- Coordinate work with other emergency medical team members, police and fire department personnel.
- Assess nature and extent of illness or injury to establish and prioritize medical procedures.
- Maintain stations, vehicles, medical and communication equipment. Must replenish first-aid equipment and drug supplies.
- The ability to lift over 200 lbs. +, The ability to work in various temperatures, indoor & outdoor work environment.
- Follow our progressive knowledge of medical protocols
 - Complete patient care reports which support Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) guidelines
 - Be able to effectively, professionally, and compassionately work with citizens from various backgrounds
- Valid Driver’s License with an acceptable driving record.
- Maintains Current Drivers License, Georgia Paramedic License, ACLS, BLS & other required training hours
- Ensure that quality, clinical standards are practice at all times
- The ability to drive an ambulance and to obey all of the state of Georgia driving regulations.
- The ability to make quick decision making at all times.
- Completes and transfers patient care information and records as per established procedures.
- Inspects emergency medical equipment to ensure service ability and compliance with safety and infection control regulations and standards.
